Problems during pregnancy can be caused by:

- Stress
- Poor nutrition
- Tobacco use
- Alcohol use
- Drug use
- Depression or anxiety
- Domestic violence
- Lack of prenatal care

Problems that can occur:

- Poor growth
- Premature birth or low birth weight
- Eating and sleeping problems
- Developmental delays
- Excessive crying
- Learning disabilities



Remember. . . .

It's never okay to use alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs during pregnancy. But it is never too late to stop using them. Because a baby is developing the entire nine months, stopping use at any stage will improve his or her chances for a healthier life. What greater gift could a mother give a child?

KIDS NOW helps you find the services you need to have a healthy baby.

A case manager understands how stressful pregnancy can be, and is there to listen and to help you find the services you and your baby need.

You can see a **KIDS NOW** case manager at any time during your pregnancy and for up to two months after delivery.

There is no charge to you for **KIDS NOW** services.

Throughout your pregnancy you will receive free gifts for you and your baby.

KIDS NOW Services

KIDS NOW case management services include:

- Support and encouragement
- Referral to prenatal and well baby care
- Referral to “Healthy Baby Classes”
- Help with tobacco, alcohol and drug problems
- Information about available community resources such as:
 - * Housing and other basic needs
 - * Mental health counseling
 - * Domestic violence services
 - * Smoking cessation assistance
