PROFESSIONAL TRAININGS:

- ◆ In-service trainings are available to build skills in assessment and treatment of victim related issues

CONSULTATION AND REFERRAL

- ◆ Consultation to area providers who work with survivors of rape, sexual assault, domestic violence and child abuse
- ◆ Referrals to community resources including crisis stabilization unit, domestic violence shelter, legal services, and public assistance

- ◆ Crisis Counseling
- ◆ Individual Counseling
- ◆ Group Counseling
- ◆ Psychiatric services and medication management



PREVENTION EFFORTS:

Green Dot Strategy:

Engaging individuals in a violence prevention movement called the **Green Dot** Strategy.

Green Dots symbolize single moments in time that can be used to end acts of violence or support victims of abuse.

Community Teams:

Empowering community members to unite in taking an active role in ending violence.

ADVOCACY

- ◆ Provides Advocates who assist victims of sexual assault, domestic violence and child abuse in hospital emergency rooms and accompanies victims during court proceedings



PERSONAL ADVOCACY

- ◆ Advocates who provide information and referrals for legal, medical, law enforcement and for other community resources

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

- ◆ Provides to the community a 40-hour training program (free of charge) to train individuals (20 years or older) to become Medical Advocates, Court Advocates or Program Volunteers (Program Volunteers assist staff with various projects).

Our services are **CONFIDENTIAL** and are available free of charge for everyone who has survived sexual assault, child abuse, or domestic violence, without regard to race, religion, color, national origin, sex, pregnancy, sexual preference, age, disability or victimization status.
